### A letter from our Director

I wish that I could tell you that the need for our services has declined. I wish that we didn't need more office space and staff to help us battle against the trauma and burden placed upon innocent children. The reality is that . . . . I can't. I can't because every day at least two new children walk through our doors needing services.

Why do we continue to exist? Why do we value your support? Simply put, "a child's life is on the line." You make the difference between a child having nightmares or not. You are the defense against fears for safety during waking hours. You are the tangible hope for survival. The bridge that links yesterday's pain with tomorrow's healing.

With proper intervention and services we provide, victims of abuse can resume normal functioning and thrive. We provided over 4,000 services to children and families last year even in the midst of a pandemic. All free of charge. No child victim of abuse should ever be denied access to healing based on financial restraints. Thus, the Butterfly Bridge (hildren's Advocacy (enter relies heavily on donations to continue to provide invaluable services to these families.

We are the only child advocacy center in Chilton, Autauga, and Elmore counties providing a safe haven that offers hope and healing to victims. We need your help to continue to offer the services these children need to overcome the trauma of sexual abuse, physical abuse, and neglect and the perpetual cycle of destruction that it can leave in its wake.

2020 has been a challenging year for all of us. During this pandemic, our center has NoT closed, and our work has not stopped. In fact, in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, we provided 4,246 of our core services to 362 children who walked through our doors for the first time. We pledge to continue our work to improve the lives of child abuse victims in our community – children who need us in these tough times even more than ever.

Specially trained staff members at Butterfly Bridge CAC conduct legally justifiable fact-finding interviews with children at the request of law enforcement or the Department of Human Resources during child abuse investigations. The interviews are designed to allow a child to disclose abuse if abuse has occurred.



Butterfly Bridge CAC utilizes evidence-based, trauma-informed interventions to allow child

victims and their non-offending family members the chance to heal from abuse. We believe when offered community support, the family's chances for restoration increase greatly. Services to promote restoration include: therapeutic services for children who have experienced trauma as a result of abuse, psycho-educational support groups for their non-offending family members, and referrals to other needed community resources.

This program of Butterfly Bridge CAC is designed to provide a continuum of care for children and families throughout the criminal justice process. We provide


security to children victimized by abuse or neglect by working closely with the local multi-disciplinary team of professionals who investigate cases of alleged abuse. Together, we assess needs and risks the child may face. We also provide support through the process by coordinating and tracking the efforts of the different professionals working each child's case, from intake through trial proceedings, to make sure no clients' needs go unmet.




Butterfly Bridge CAC coordinates intervention among child welfare professionals in Chilton, Autauga, and Elmore counties to ensure protection of victims and their non-offending family members. Prior to the inception of the Children's Advocacy Center model, efforts to investigate and prosecute were

often duplicated and inefficient. In a criminal justice system designed around adults, child victims were revictimized by the system, having to retell their abuse stories to multiple investigators. Criminal cases were often weakened by the lack of coordination between agencies. Working collaboratively with law enforcement and DHR, services and resources are efficiently leveraged to provide healing to abused children. Communication across agencies strengthens criminal cases so that perpetrators can be held accountable, keeping our community safe.


#### **Reason For Referral**


